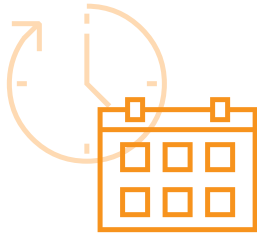

## Your future career field

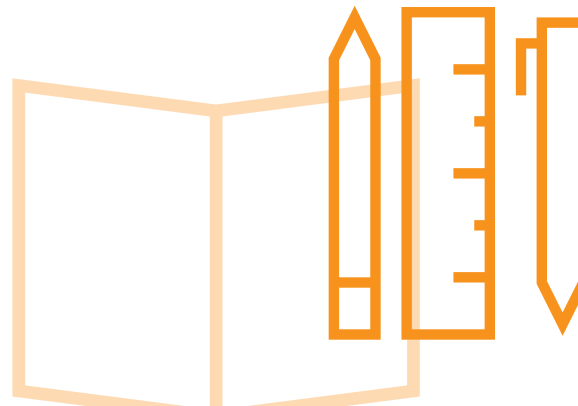
There will be many options open to you for your career entry. Among other things, the degree will allow you to start your career in internal or classic management consulting. Your consulting know-how also offers you entry opportunities in staff and line functions in industrial and service companies. But you will also have the opportunity to find a career in consulting and management-related activities in the public sector and in the academic field.

## Your degree program

The cooperative degree program with the University of Oldenburg offers you a comprehensive insight into theoretical and practical content. During your studies, you will acquire basic methodological and implementation skills for advisory activities in and of organisations. In addition, during the first three semesters you will get to know and apply counselling-specific instruments as well as develop and implement efficient problem solutions. Already during your studies, you will be able to apply your theoretical knowledge in projects with companies in a very concrete way. In the last semester, you will write your Master's thesis. After four semesters, this programme offers you a university degree with further options that will have prepared you for responsible tasks in the consulting industry, in the higher civil service or for a possible doctorate.
